Sunday the 20 July.

Above times are estimated, it may slightly differ in real time.

Gun control: It is the responsibility of the individual shooter to provide proofs of the historical correctness of his guns, and the ammunition used if this question arises.

Protest deadline: One hour after the results are posted. For the last competition on Saturday, the protest deadline will be 09:30 Sunday morning.

Firearm's customs declaration for participants from Denmark, Finland and Norway

Replicas and any firearms manufactured after 1890 require a permit and must be declared at the Swedish customs. Muzzle loaded firearms manufactured before 1890 (originals) don't need any permit or declaration, but any firearm using "gas tight" cartridges (Smith & Wesson, Remington rifle, Jarman and Husqvarna classes) require a permit and must be declared at the customs.

The customs declaration can be made using the Swedish custom's website and then you can take the "green" line when entering Sweden. The address to the Swedish customs firearm's declaration page is:
